



Data Protection - Privacy Notice (Job Applicants)

Under data protection law, individuals have a right to be informed about how the Trust uses any personal data that we hold about you. We have created 'privacy notices' to individuals processing their personal data.

This privacy notice explains how we collect, store and use personal data about you applying for jobs at

We, Wade Deacon Trust (C/O Wade Deacon High School, Pirbright Road, Widnes, WA9 7TD) are the 'data controller' for the purposes of data protection law

Successful candidates should refer to our privacy notice for staff for information about how their personal data is collected, stored and used.

The personal data we hold

We may hold the following personal data about you:

- Contact details
- CVs and other work documentation
- References
- Evidence of qualifications, including employment records, including work history, job titles, training courses and professional memberships
- Teacher status (e.g. QTS/EYTS status, Induction status, ITT result) and decisions in relation to applications for roles (e.g. selection or suitability) or assessment in relation to an individual's membership of the member states)
- Photographs
- CCTV images captured in school
- Evidence of any concerns in the public domain regarding suitability to work with children

We may also hold the following personal data about you, where applicable:

- Reasons for any exclusion or suspension from the profession
- Disability and access requirements

Why we use this data

The purpose of processing this data is to:

- Enabling us to establish relevant experience and qualifications
- Enabling us to communicate with you regarding your application
- Facilitating safe recruitment, as part of our safeguarding obligations towards pupils
- Enabling equalities monitoring

Essential to the recruitment process, and we may also collect information from candidates that require them

Our lawful basis for using this data

We only collect and use personal information about you where the law allows us to. Most commonly, we use it where we need to:

- Comply with a legal obligation
- Carry out a task in the public interest

Less commonly, we may also use personal information about you where:

- You have given us consent to use it in a certain way
- It is in our interests or someone else's interests. We need to protect our

When you have provided us with consent to process your data, you may withdraw this consent at any time. We will make this clear when requesting your consent, and explain how you go about withdrawing consent if you wish to do so.

Some of the reasons listed above for collecting and using personal information about you overlap, and there may be several grounds which justify the school's use of your data.

Can I stop this information?

While the majority of the information we collect from you is mandatory, there is some information that you can choose whether or not to provide to us.

Whenever we seek to collect information from you, we make it clear whether you must provide this information

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, we will not release information if it is exempt from release. We will carry out an

How we store this data

Personal data we collect as part of the job application process is stored in line with our data protection policy. If you would like a copy of the record retention policy,

Data sharing

Where it is legally required, or necessary (credit agencies with data protection law) and we have your consent, our policies allow us to do so.

Your rights

Individuals have a right to make a 'subject access request' to gain access to personal information that the school holds about them.

If you make a subject access request and if we do hold information about you, we will:

Give you a description of it

and how long we will keep it for

Explain where we got it from, if not from you

Tell you who it has been, or will be, shared with.

Let you know whether any automated decision-making is being applied to the data, and any

Give you a copy of the information in an intelligible form.
